

Strawberry Point City Council
Work Session April 21, 2021

The Strawberry Point City Council met for a work session on Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. at the Council Chambers of City Hall. Mayor Hannah Evans presided. Council members present were Courtnage and Gearhart, with Gould participating via speakerphone. Also in attendance were Josh Demmer with Demmer Architecture, Public Works Superintendent Erik Sauerbry, and representatives of the Strawberry Point Public Library and Berry Tender Child Care.

Gearhart made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Courtnage seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Ayes: Courtnage, Gould, Gearhart. Nays: None. Motion passes.

NEW BUSINESS

Demmer led a discussion pertaining to the focus for Civic Center and Library improvement priorities. Hansel arrived at 5:45PM and Rowcliffe arrived at 6:12PM. In summary, Council identified the library wall as the most imperative issue to address, followed by the acoustics of the Civic Center Multi Purpose Room, and heating/cooling in the Civic Center. It was also the consensus of the Council to proceed with the proposed elements as one project versus addressing each item individually, and to do so on an accelerated timeline to take advantage of interest rates and material prices as they continue to rise. Demmer will prepare a contract and proposal for consideration at the next City Council meeting.
