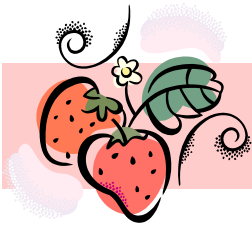
Lutheran Home to Host Pre-Holiday Bazaar

winners were Logan Atkin, Jack Thole, and Maire Powell. Thank you to those businesses that participated!

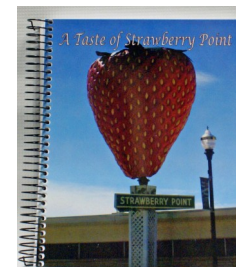


Strawberry Point Cookbooks Have Arrived!
