Chamber to Host A Berry Merry Christmas on Dec. 4



On Saturday, December 4, the Strawberry Point Chamber of Commerce is hosting "A Berry Merry Christmas." There will be plenty of fun events and activities happening around town. Participating businesses will have their holiday open houses and the Wilder Memorial Museum will also have a holiday open house from 11-4 p.m. Horse-drawn carriage rides will start at the Civic Center and be available all afternoon. The Lion's Club will host a luncheon at the Civic Center from 11-2 p.m. complete with maid-rites and other delicious food. Once you are finished shopping in the downtown, come up to the Civic Center as there will be over a dozen vendors selling items that are sure to finish off your Christ-

mas list. Vendors will be there from 11-4 pm. Christmas is a time when we should remember those serving in the military as many of them will be away this Christmas. There will be a booth at the Civic Center from 11-4 p.m. where kids and adults alike can decorate and make Christmas cards for our local service men and women. There will also be a cookie walk at the Civic Center where you can choose from an assortment of cookies baked by Strawberry Point's best bakers. Grab as many as you can to fill a box that will be provided. The library has invited Santa Claus to come again from 1-3 p.m. Kids can have a free photo taken from Santa by the Press-Journal and they will also receive a gift. The library will also have holiday crafts for kids and will again host the Christmas Tree Festival from Dec. 4-18. Businesses and organi-

zations are encouraged to decorate their own tree and place it in the library from November 29-December 3rd. The public will be invited to vote on their favorite trees from December 4-18 and prizes will then be awarded with an announcement in the Press-Journal. The lighting of the town's Christmas Tree will take place in Inger Park at 5:00 followed by the Santa Buck's drawing, music by the Star-mont high school chorus, and bonfire. Participating businesses who have Santa Buck tickets, remember to bring them to the Franklin Hotel before 4:30 on December 4th. The Franklin will host a wine and dine event from 6-9 p.m. that night. We hope that you can celebrate "A Berry Merry Christmas" with us!



Decorate a Tree for the Library's Christmas Tree Festival

If you are a business or organization, you are invited to decorate your own tree and bring it to the library anytime from November 29-December 3rd. Trees should have a sign on the top of the tree or on the foot of the tree saying what business or organization it is from. Trees will be judged by the public starting December 4

and ending on Saturday, December 18th. The voting will be based on a penny or "change" vote. Boxes will be located under each tree and the boxes with the most change on December 18 will be declared winners. Prizes will be awarded. This is a great way to promote your business while making the library
