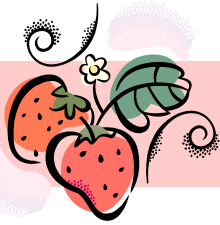

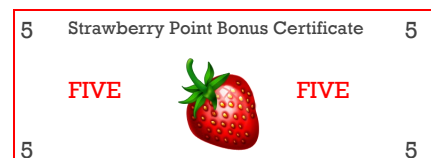


New Chamber Bucks Now Available
