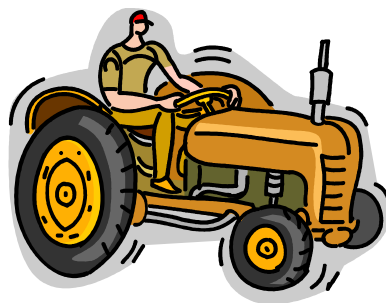
Lutheran Hosts "County Fair"
