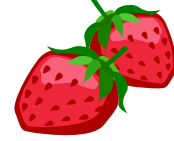


WELCOME TO STRAWBERRY POINT!

CITY UTILITIES

The City of Strawberry Point provides service for electric, water, sewer, garbage and recycling. Bills for the city provided utilities are mailed on the first of each month and are payable on the 20th of each month. Any bill not paid by the due date will be considered delinquent, have a penalty added, and will have disconnection proceedings started. If service is disconnected for non-payment, a reconnect fee of \$75 during regular business hours and an after-hours reconnect fee of \$100.

Garbage and recycling pickup is done curbside on Thursday of each week. Each residential customer is allowed (1) 33 gallon bag or can, not to exceed 40 pounds per week. Each additional bag or can must have a tag on it. Garbage tags may be purchased at City Hall for \$1.50 each. All recycled material must be placed in a recycling container and placed at the curb. All recyclables will be picked up co-mingled, except for glass. You may purchase a recycling bin at City Hall for \$8.00. The monthly garbage charge included on your utility bill is \$10.50.

PARKING

There is a street ordinance in town that prohibits parking on all City streets 2:00am to 6:00am from November 1st to April 1st. There are signs posted throughout town and violators may be issued parking tickets.

PARKS

The City of Strawberry Point maintains two parks – Inger and Campbell.

Inger Park is located off of Park Avenue, directly behind City Hall and has playground equipment, shelter house, and band shell available for use.

Campbell Park is located on Campbell Drive next to the City Swimming Pool. Campbell Park is in a more secluded area and offers playground equipment and a shelter house for use. The City also has an athletic field for use, which has a baseball diamond, volleyball court, and ample room for football.

CIVIC CENTER

The Civic Center rooms are available to the public to rent for any occasion.

The multi-purpose room seats over 150 and has a newly remodeled kitchen available for use. For smaller groups you may want to use the Scout or Senior Citizens rooms, which have no kitchen. Please note that no alcohol is permitted on the Civic Center grounds. To rent a room in the Civic Center or for the room rental rates, please contact City Hall.

LIBRARY

The Strawberry Point Public Library is located at 401 Commercial Street, right next to the Civic Center. Hours are:
