

Strawberry Point City Council  
Special Meeting May 28, 2008

The Strawberry Point City Council met for a special meeting on Wednesday, May 28, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Fox presided and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members answering roll call were Jan Parkin, Al Friederich, Jackie Opperman, Norm Rizer and Troy Stover.

**OLD BUSINESS**

The reason for this special meeting was to discuss how to advertise for the upcoming open position due to Adam Fette submitting his resignation. Adam's last day with the City will be June 13<sup>th</sup>. Dick Neis, Chairman of the Electric Study Committee was present and provided some information about the electric utility. After much discussion about the electric position and the other needs of the City, Stover moved to advertise for a lineman/journeyman with the expectations that the applicant will need to assist with other departments as necessary. The applicant must also either possess a Water/Wastewater Certification I or be willing to get it. Friederich seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion passes.

The advertisement will be placed in all the major newspapers in Iowa and on various websites. Resumes will be accepted until June 20<sup>th</sup> and then the interviewing process will begin, with members of the Electric Study present for the interviews.

Opperman moved to waive the meeting pay for this special meeting. Stover seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion passes.

**OTHER BUSINESS**

There was some discussion about the past weekend weather and what the City would do if we encountered such a disaster. Storm shelters for those who live in mobile homes were also discussed. City Hall, Civic Center and the Fire Station are the cities storm shelters. The Fire Station is the only one that can be accessed in the evening or on the weekend. Additional protocol in the event of a disaster will be discussed and will be outlined so people know who needs to be where.

With nothing further, Opperman moved to adjourn at 7:00: p.m. Stover seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion passes.
