

Strawberry Point City Council
Special Meeting September 25, 2007

The Strawberry Point City Council met for a special meeting on Wednesday, September 25, 2007 at 6:30 p.m. Mayor Schmidt presided and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members answering roll call were Dale Fox, Norm Rizer, Bill Green, David Gould, and Dean Courtnage.

Larry Burger from Speer Financial was present. Mr. Burger gave a brief overview of the services Speer Financial can offer to the City. He also presented a proposal to the city for services for putting together a financial review of our capital plan. The proposal also consists of review of our current outstanding debt.

Mr. Burger also discussed with the council a TIF report that Speer Financial can compile for the City. Speer Financial updates this report annually. Mr. Burger offered a brief description of what a TIF area is and how a City can utilize the district.

Dale Fox moved to enter into the proposal with Speer Financial to conduct a financial review for our capital plan. Bill Green seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Ayes: Courtnage, Gould, Green, Rizer, and Fox. Nays: None. Motion was carried.

The City will look into what area is in the TIF district currently and what could possibly be added. The City Clerk will contact Upper Explorerland and see where the best areas would be to include in our TIF district.

OTHER BUSINESS

The brackets to hold the plaques on the light poles are done and will soon be mounted and plaques will be installed.

Gould moved to adjourn at 8:52 p.m. Rizer seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion passes.
