

City of Strawberry Point City Council  
Special Meeting on October 24, 2007

The Strawberry Point City Council met for a special meeting on Wednesday, October 24, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Schmidt presided and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members answering roll call were David Gould, Norm Rizer, Bill Green, and Dale Fox. Councilman Courtnage came a little late.

The main purpose for this special meeting was to conduct second interviews for the Police Officer position. Interviews with the candidates were held. Following the interviews the council discussed the candidates and their qualifications. After a lengthy discussion, Dale Fox moved to offer the position of Police Officer to Duane Borrett. Norm Rizer seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Ayes: Courtnage, Gould, Green, Rizer and Fox. Nays: None. Motion passes.

Compensation was then discussed for the new officer. Bill Green moved to offer Duane Borrett a starting wage of \$13.00 per hour. Then following completion of the Police Academy training the hourly wage will go to \$14.00 per hour. After six months, following a satisfactory performance review his wage will go to \$14.50 per hour. David Gould seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Ayes: Rizer, Fox, Green, Gould and Courtnage. Nays: None. Motion passes.

A contract between the City of Strawberry Point and Duane Borrett pertaining to the Police Academy training and if employment is terminated prior to the end of the contract will be discussed at the next regular meeting.

Gould moved and Fox seconded to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 9:34 p.m.
