

Strawberry Point City Council
Budget Workshop January 28, 2009

The Strawberry Point City Council met for a special meeting on Wednesday, January 28, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Fox presided and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members answering roll call were Jackie Opperman, Jan Parkin, Al Friederich, Troy Stover and Norm Rizer.

Council received Police Officer Moser's resignation. Friederich moved to accept Officer Moser's resignation with regret. Rizer seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion passes. The council addressed replacing Officer Moser and possibly using reserves until we get someone hired. Chief Pope would like to hire reserves to help patrol the City. Rizer moved to use the County for law enforcement on an as needed basis. Stover seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion passes. We will discuss the Chief possibly going back to hourly instead of salary during this time at the next meeting.

The main purpose of this special meeting was to work on the 2009-2010 budgets. Also in attendance were the City Superintendent and Police Chief. The council will continue to work on the budget February 11, 2009.

The council briefly discussed St. Foods and how we proceed. The owner of St. Foods will be asked to be in attendance at the February 4th council meeting to review this.

With no further business, Opperman moved to adjourn at 9:57 p.m. Friederich seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion passes.
