

Strawberry Point City Council
Budget Workshop February 13, 2008

The Strawberry Point City Council met for a special meeting on Wednesday, February 13, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Fox presided and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members answering roll call were Jan Parkin, Jackie Opperman, Norm Rizer, Al Friederich and Troy Stover.

Council reviewed a real estate subordination agreement for property at 109 E. Elm Street. This subordination is due to the property having a First Time Homebuyer Forgivable Loan and wanting to refinance their primary mortgage. The subordination puts the City in second place for creditors. Norm Rizer moved to accept this subordination, which puts the City in second place. Al Friederich seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion passes.

The main purpose of this special meeting was to work on the 2008-2009 budgets. Also in attendance was Jeff Robinson, City Superintendent and Fire Chief. At the conclusion of this budget workshop the general fund will be positive at the conclusion of the 2009 fiscal year.

OTHER BUSINESS

With no further business, Opperman moved to adjourn at 8:18 p.m. Friederich seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion passes.
