

Strawberry Point City Council  
Special Meeting July 9, 2008

The Strawberry Point City Council met for a special meeting on Wednesday, July 9, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Fox presided and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members answering roll call were Jan Parkin, Al Friederich, Troy Stover, Jackie Opperman, and Norm Rizer.

**OLD BUSINESS**

The council again discussed the air conditioning units for the library. Opperman moved to authorize Weber's to replace the two compressors at the library. Stover seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion passes.

The Library had some water on the floor during the heavy rain Monday night. The extensions for the downspouts had come off. They were reattached and hopefully this will prevent any further water problems.

There was additional discussion concerning filling the vacant city position. We had advertised for a journeyman/lineman and received no such applicants. We discussed contracting with Wessel's Electric for the City electric service. This will be discussed with him. We will be advertising for a water, wastewater, and street position. The applications will be accepted until July 30<sup>th</sup>. The interviewing committee will consist of the water and wastewater council representative, city administrator and city superintendent.

Council was asked about making a donation to the demolition of the house on Commercial Street. Friederich moved that we do not donate money for the housing demolition and that he takes advantage of the housing incentives offered by the City. Opperman seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion passes.

**OTHER BUSINESS**

The City was asked for a donation or swimming passes to the Paul Olinger benefit. No action was taken. Council members can do something personally if they choose.

With nothing further, Friederich moved to adjourn at 8:25 p.m. Rizer seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion passes.
