Morning Ashley,

First, here is information on what the City of Strawberry Point is be responsible for and what the DOT is be responsible for crosswalks:

City of Strawberry Point

- Sidewalks and ADA ramps
- Paint crossing

DOT

- Possible warning signs

Secondly, here are your individual request reviews:

- IA 3/Campbell Dr
 - City of Strawberry Point would need to
 - Install sidewalks on east side of the roadway. – need somewhere for pedestrian to go.
 - Install ADA Ramps for crossing roadway
 - Paint crosswalk and maintain paint
 - I question the need for the crossing as there is currently sidewalks on the west side of the roadway and from what I see not very many houses and possibility of pedestrian coming from the east side of the roadway.
 - Work for ADA Ramps and sidewalks would need to be permitted through the DOT - Jess Ellingson. Here is the link to that permit. [\[Iowa DOT\] 810028: Application to Perform Work within State Highway Right of Way](#)
- IA 3 - At the 400 Block (near the Library/Civic Center)
 - I would recommend this crossing be at E Elm St and IA 3/Commercial St. – This would be the closest city street and is where motorist would expect to see pedestrians.
 - This location does have sidewalks and ADA ramps
 - City would need to paint this crosswalk
 - DOT could place the Pedestrian Crossing Warning signs.
- IA 3/W Mission Street - At the 500 Block (near Dollar General)
 - I would keep with the recommendation of having a crossing at a city street again for the reasoning drivers expect to see pedestrians at intersections along with entering vehicles so they are typically more alert for this at an intersection. In this case I would recommend at Sunset Knoll. There would need to be sidewalks and ADA Ramps installed and painting done by the City of Strawberry Point permitted from the DOT.
- Additional speed limit signage for the southbound lane of Commercial Street, specifically at its intersections with Lincoln Street and Fults Street.
 - Following the Guidance from the Department of Transportations Traffic and Safety Manual Chapter 2A-8 Sign Placement and Specifically Speed Limit Sign Placement. The DOT could place an additional Speed

Limit 30 MPH sign approx. 285' south of Lincoln St. I will get this request out to our maintenance garage and as weather and time permits will get this installed.

In summary

- Pedestrian crossing need to done by the City of Strawberry Point and permitted through the DOT.
- The DOT will install the Warning Signs for these crossing once permitted and complete.
- DOT will install additional Speed Limit 30 sign for SB IA 3/Commercial St.
