Ron Landis came before the Council concerning the request for a private party. Motion by Rima, second by Baumgartner to charge a fee of \$40. per hour for private parties at the pool after hours. The city will then supply lifeguards and all fees shall be paid directly to the city. All regulations for the pool will be in effect for these parties. All ayes carried.

Private lessons have been requested. Motion by Rima, second by Pattison to have the City sponsor private lessons for \$15 per hour to be collected and scheduled by the pool manager. Roll taken: ayes: Baumgartner, Pattison, Rima, O'Donnell. Naves: Schuchmann, carried.

Discussion was held concerning the management of the pool budget. No action was taken or changes made.

A. Faust came before the Council to present her resignation in order to retire. Motion by O'Donnell, second by Schuchmann to accept her resignation with best wishes for her retirement. Carried.

Motion by Baumgartner, second by Pattison authorizing the Mayor to sign an easement requested by the County Supervisors giving Weger Farms, Inc. access to their property. Carried.

Discussion was held concerning the damage and vandalism occurring after the last two dances at the Grange-Skyline. Motion by Pattison, second by Schuchmann directing the city attorney to contact the Grange concerning this matter. Carried.

Supt. Ohl advised the Council that a trailer for the previously purchased mower was available. Motion by Schuchmann second by Baumgartner to purchase the trailer from the H. Stade Estate for \$100. Carried.

A letter from Flieher and Schloss Law firm was read to the Council presenting a gift of \$200. for the library building trust. Motion by Schuchmann, second by O'Donnell to accept the gift with thanks. Carried.

Motion by Baumgartner, second by Rima to adjourn. Adjournment was at 9:45 pm. The next Council meeting is scheduled for July 20, 1983 in the Council Chambers of City Hall.
