Good Morning – an email was sent November 5th 2021 to all the electric members regarding the changes made to Chapter 27 of the Iowa Administrative Code which will now require electric municipal utilities to adopt, update and file an annual electric reliability plan by April 1st of each year. We realize some utilities already have reliability plans that are used to determine if improvements are needed for their electric system. However, we also realize not all members have a formal plan and IAMU has created a template which may be used meet this requirement. The template can be accessed on the IAMU website by going to https://members.iamu.org/page/Electric_Resources click reliability plan and complete the jot form. Once the form has been completed click submit; it will send an email with a PDF that you in turn will be able to submit to the Iowa Utility Board.

Also, since the original email was sent we've received some number of questions from members regarding this new requirement and have hopefully addressed them all. One recurring question we've received is regarding the need to file a tariff. This was part of the original Chapter 27 draft however, IAMU was successful in getting this language removed and you DO NOT need to file a tariff just the reliability plan.

Remember, the plan will have to be approved by your Board or Council, and filed with the IUB no later than April 1, 2022; if you have any questions regarding this process please contact Alex Cutchey acutchey@iamu.org or Jared Masker jmasker@iamu.org
