

Strawberry Point City Council
Budget Work Session January 10, 2022

The Strawberry Point City Council met for a budget work session on Monday, January 10, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. at the Council Chambers of City Hall. Mayor Hannah Evans presided and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members present were Hansel, Yokiell, Courtnage, Gearhart, Gould.

Hansel made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Gearhart seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Ayes: Hansel, Yokiell, Courtnage, Gearhart, Gould. Motion passes.

NEW BUSINESS

Council reviewed the FY2022-2023 budget expenditure requests for each General Fund department. While maintaining the same total tax levy rate as the past two years, Council balanced the budget based on the need of each department. Staff was requested to conduct additional research on addressing runoff concerns at the Wilder Memorial Museum property and painting the strawberry with these initiatives to be considered throughout the year as information becomes available. Council also opted to delay allocation of the traffic camera revenue until multiple months of collections can be used to better estimate the total annual revenue.
